Sick Bank Glossary (June 2016)

Word	Definition
Prolonged	An absence that exceeds 10 consecutive duty days.
Catastrophic	A severe condition that affects the mental/physical health of the employee, results in a life threatening or functional life altering condition, and requires a prolonged period of absence from work. Episodic occurrences or flare-ups of ongoing conditions that last fewer than 10 days are not considered prolonged or catastrophic.
Incapacitating	Inability to work, attend school or perform other regular daily activities due to the serious health condition. Requires either extended hospitalization or home confinement.
Intermittent	Period of incapacity or subsequent treatment in connection with a qualifying illness or injury. Time taken for planned treatments in connection with scheduled treatment for a catastrophic condition.
Treatment	A regimen of continuing treatment includes a course of prescription medication or therapy administered by a medical professional to resolve or alleviate the health condition. Enrolled in a rehabilitative program.
