How do I apply to get MSDE credit?

In order to get 1 MSDE credit for an NEA Micro-credential you need to complete the following steps:

1. Obtain **pre-approval** from FCPS Department of Employee Induction and Professional Learning using this link: <http://bit.ly/NEAmicro>

2. Upon approval, apply for an NEA Micro-credential at <https://cgps.nea.org/micro-credentials/>

How much does it cost?

3. You have six (6) months from the time you apply for the micro-credential to finish and submit your micro-credential

4. Submit your certification of passage to Department of Employee Induction and Professional Learning using the following email -
